This rapid growth was underpinned by the acquisition and merger of over fifty companies into the parent firm.

His tenure with FTI Consulting and development of the office infrastructure to support the Firm's tremendous growth provided the insight to establish numerous support contracts for national support services as well as improve administration across organizational boundaries.

Prior to his civilian career, Mr. Gorum served in the Navy's Civil Engineer Corps. Assigned duty in numerous locations both overseas and domestically.
